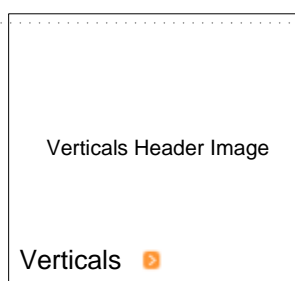

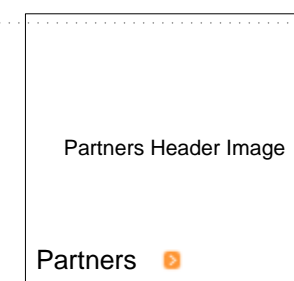

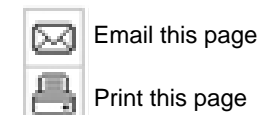

Because Surveillance is deeper than for example Data Center Consolidation, it makes more sense for the web site template to be a main section layout like Ruggedized (if the content goes to a deeper level of pages).

This option eliminates content "below the fold" and on the sub-pages, makes it more modular and easier to single-source with SPP versions of these pages.

If we go with no branding images, the page still looks fine. This also allows us to expand any section (for example, we show 6 section doors here).

Apparently the "quick links" pages within Digital Needs cannot have second-level "breadcrumb trail" links due to conflicts with channel marketing and landing page requirements, so the proposed navigation breadcrumbs (shown below) have now been removed. This means that we have a navigation issue to resolve.

We are proposing as a temporary measure to use the standard employed by the Services group (see <http://services.seagate.com/index.aspx?lng=en-us>) in order to provide internal navigation.

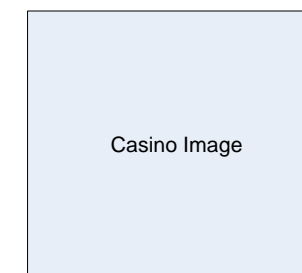

Casino, Gaming, & Hospitality

Consider the security challenges of typical casinos: often open 24 hours a day; accommodating thousands of people at a time in venues that can be larger than a football field, all with easy entrance to and exit from the facility. Such an environment invites criminal behavior, whether it be theft or pickpocketing, physical assault or cheating in the various games of chance.



And these threats do not come solely from the casino's guests. According to the Nevada Gaming Commission, between 1999-2000 the casinos' own employees accounted for over one third of those arrested for theft or cheating.

In response, many casinos take a two-tiered approach to video surveillance. The first tier employs conventional techniques (moderate image resolutions, multiple cameras for widespread coverage) with special emphasis on cash-handling areas. The second tier is more sophisticated, utilizing high-resolution streams and intelligent video surveillance software in the gaming areas to identify and track a small number of high-risk individuals (for example, professional card cheats) in very crowded settings.

Given the sheer number of people involved and the multitude of locations where potential criminal activity could take place, it should come as no surprise that casinos rely on an enormous quantity of cameras to ensure comprehensive security coverage. Moderate resolution video streams are effective for general surveillance, but the large number of cameras/streams involved places enormous demands on storage capacity. In addition, the high-resolution streams used to closely monitor gaming area activity further boost capacity requirements.

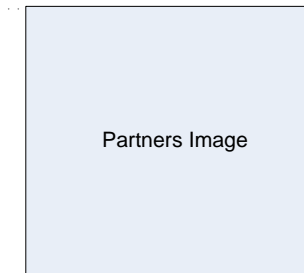

2 For now, these links will go to specific news articles, and the more links just go to the general news and events pages.

If possible, it would be great if Dipendra could link to the main news section on WWW with a parameter in the link that would tell the News page to filter the news for items tagged as being about Surveillance. (Same idea for Press releases and Events.)

- 7 Useful Links seemed like a good catch-all—you need this section for (1) items that have only one link and (2) items that don't fit anywhere else but need home page space.

- 9 Link to branding pages
- 10 This is just an example of a link that doesn't fit anywhere else. There was some discussion of a "KC flash" (not sure what that is) and other items that may come up that could go here.
- 11 Another example of adding another item; the eStore is for Premier partners only.
